

IN THE KITCHEN COOK-OFF BASIC DETAILS



- Saturday, February 22 at Magnetic South Brewery.
- Setup begins at 1:00. Competition starts at 2:00 and ends at 3:45. Winners will be announced by 4:15.
- \$20 fee for cooks to enter the competition.
- Every dish must make the flavor of pickles the hero.
- No cooking on-site.
- Cooks must bring crock-pot, hot plate, ice, serving plates, plastic ware, etc. and extension cords. (Electrical outlets will be provided.)
- Cooks must name their dish. (The more creative the better.)
- Cooks must list dish ingredients on a sign for people with food sensitivity issues to review.
- Cooks must bring enough bite-size samples 125 people (estimated attendance).
- Public will vote for their favorite dishes with prizes awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place.
- The Adaptive Pickleball Board of Directors will award one team for the most creative pickle flavored inspired dish.
- Specific day-of event directions/logistics will be sent to cooks closer to the cook-off date.
